Berkeley Police Department Patrol Officers are assigned to a specific patrol beat during a 10-hour or 12-hour shift. Each officer is responsible for his/her area, in addition to providing cover officer functions and other duties as needed for adjacent beats or team members. BPD Patrol Officers are in regular communication with other divisions within the department about crime trends, wanted individuals and community concerns. They work to reduce crime and promote overall community safety.
